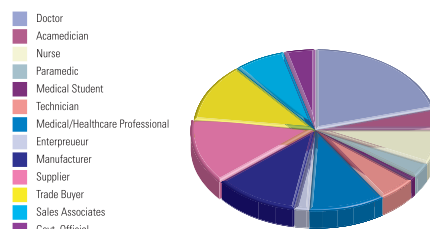

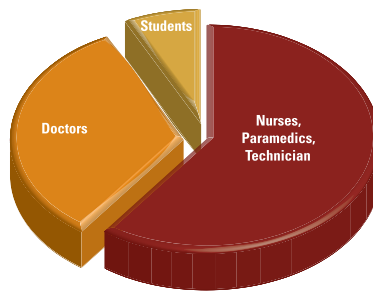


Dubai Anaesthesia Pre-Conference Course

Ultrasound Guided Regional Anaesthesia: Accredited by Dubai Health Authority, (4.75 CME hours).

The course included an overview of prerequisites for regional anaesthetic techniques under ultrasonographic guidance – Equipment, education, skills and organization, Basics of Ultrasound Technique and Blocks, Upper Extremity, Lower Extremity, Needling, Advanced Ultrasound Technique and Blocks, Paravertebral, Intercostal and Cervical.

Pre-Conference Courses

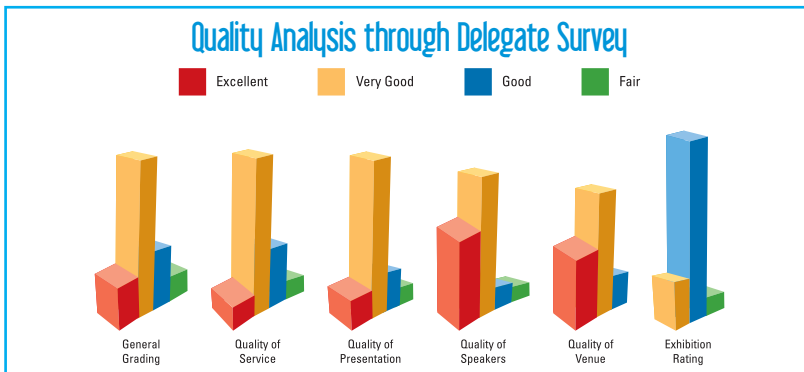
BASIC Assessment and Support in Intensive Care: (15 CME hours from IPACCM). The faculty included regional and International instructors under the efficient guidance of Prof. Charles Gomersall, who was the Director of the course.

Critical Care Ultrasound Course: (8 CME hours by accredited by IPACCM).

Ultrasonic examination in critically ill course emphasised the increasing importance of the technique for critical care used in both central venous procedures and diagnosis.

Advanced Bronchoscopy Course: (8 CME hours by IPACCM).

Utility of Bronchoscopy in the ICU and various sampling techniques to improve the diagnostic field was discussed with hands on workshops and practical demonstration.

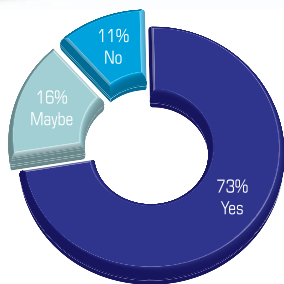


Social Activities
