Tube India International 2010 and Metallurgy India 2010: Global footprint on the Indian Subcontinent

The 4th edition of Tube India International and the 3rd edition of Metallurgy India - the international trade fairs for the tube, pipe and metallurgy industry in Mumbai exceeded expectations.

The event was held from February 10 to 12, 2010 in an area of 12,000 sqm with the presence of 274 exhibitors from 22 countries. More than 6,420 registered visitors visited from 29 countries. The shows witnessed an increase of 27% in the number of Exhibitors and 60% in the number of Visitors in comparison to the earlier editions of the event.

The emerging Indian market with time has become one of the most dynamic economies in the world and this potential was highlighted at these fairs. Bearing in mind such pulsating circumstances within the industry, exhibitors had high expectations about the returns from the trade fairs, which were met generously. The discussions at the booths saw a delightful exchange of ideas, comprehensive new dialogues with interesting and promising delivery of business even after the fairs.

The exhibitors at these 2 fairs displayed an extensive range of equipment, machinery and technology to the visitors.

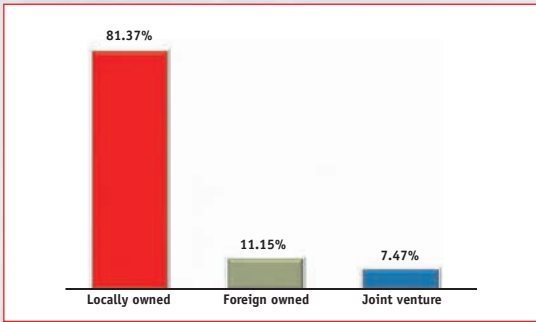

The theme of the 1-day seminar was "Mission Metallurgy India".

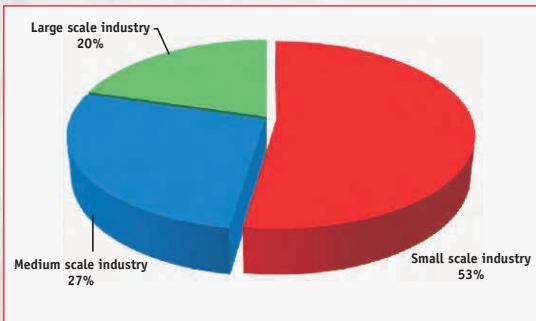




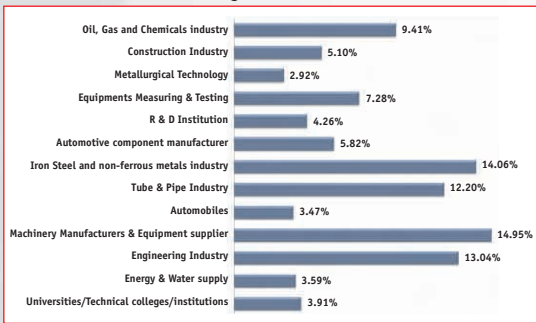

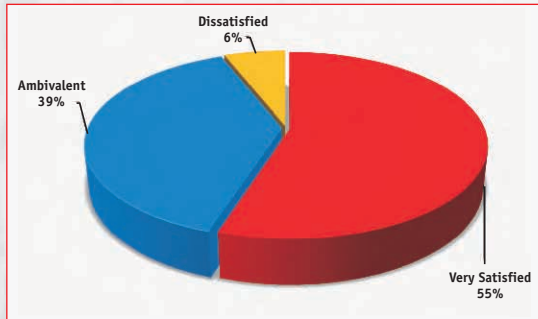
Objectives of Trade Fair Participation



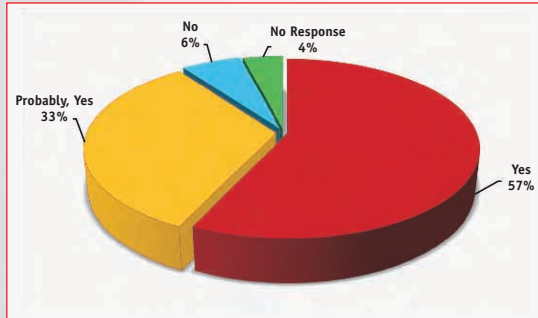

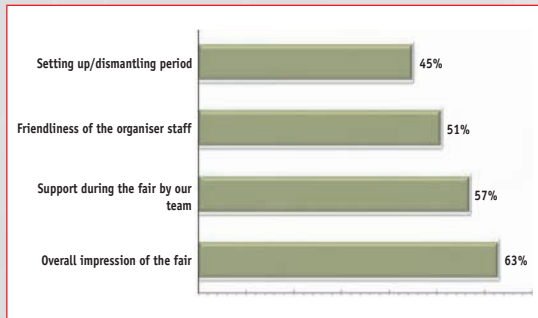
