The three-day-long oil and gas exhibition Atyrau Oil & Gas presented **130 companies** from **14 countries** such as China, Denmark, Germany, Italy, Kazakhstan, the Netherlands, Poland, Romania, Russia, Slovakia, Spain, Turkey, the United Kingdom, and the United States.

The growing number of companies from Germany is worth special mentioning as they presented the world-known brands and leading German manufacturers.

For the first time, the Royal Embassy of the Netherlands organised a presentation of a group of industrial enterprises during the exhibition.

An ever growing interest from domestic enterprises in this event is a good sign to note – in 2008, they made up more than 45% of all exhibitors. This complies with the goals of the exhibition: to maintain and improve the competitiveness of Kazakhstani oil and gas enterprises.

**The total area of Atyrau Oil & Gas 2008 was 3,000 m<sup>2</sup>.**

**The exhibition was attended by more than 3,300 specialists.**

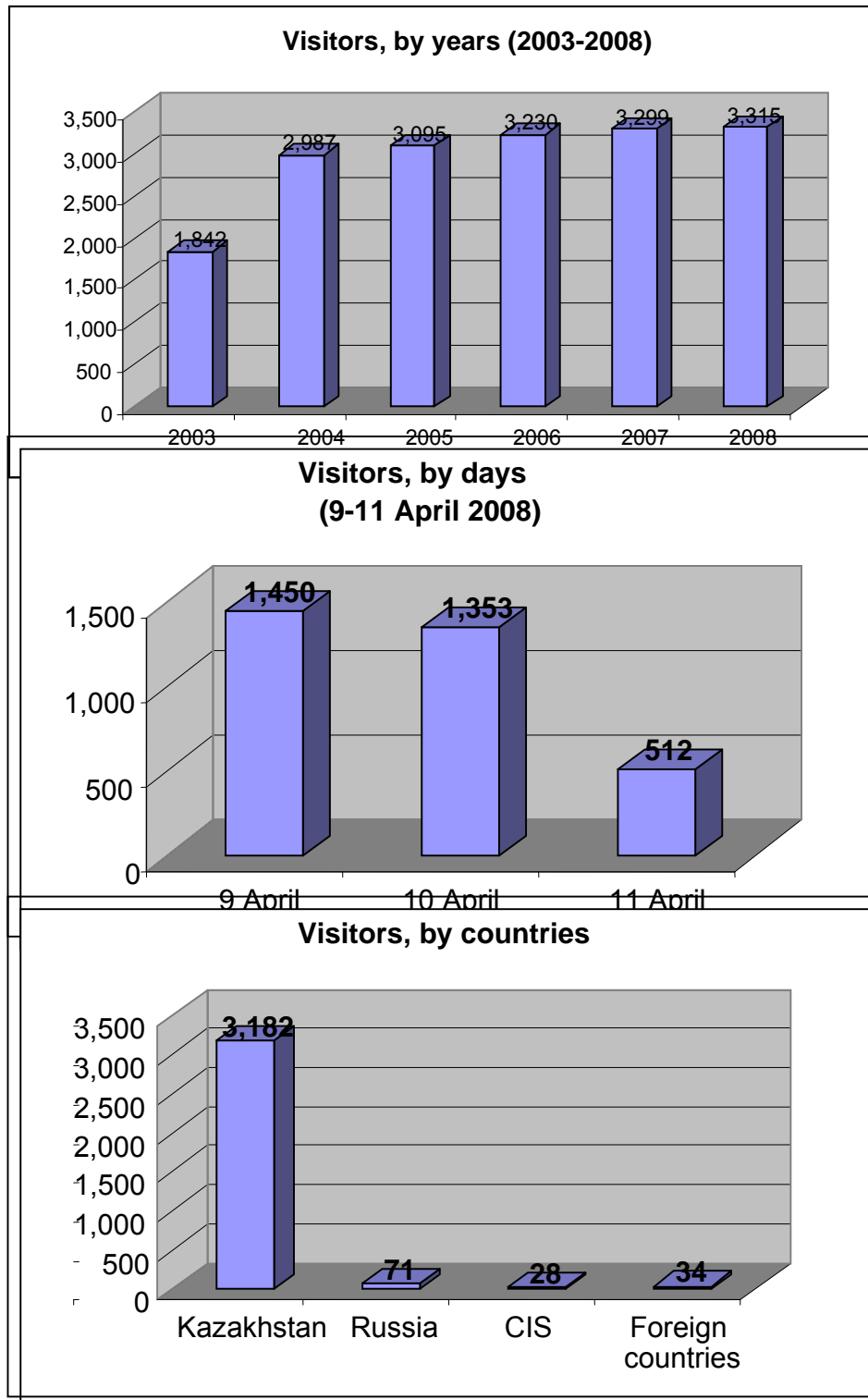

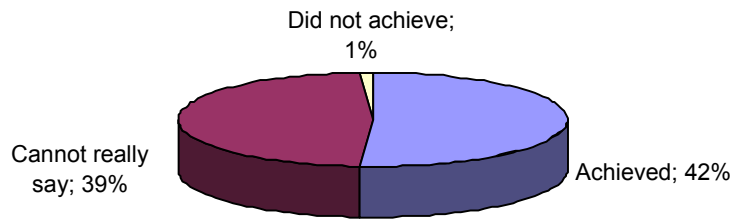

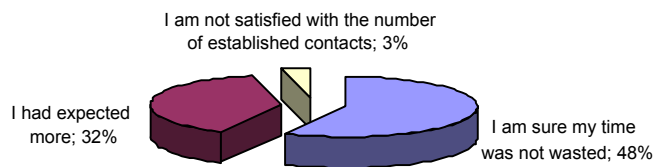
