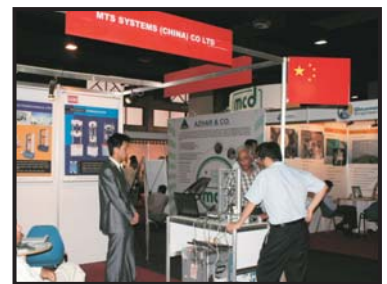

The ceremony was largely attended by diplomats, trade delegates, Government officials and media representatives.



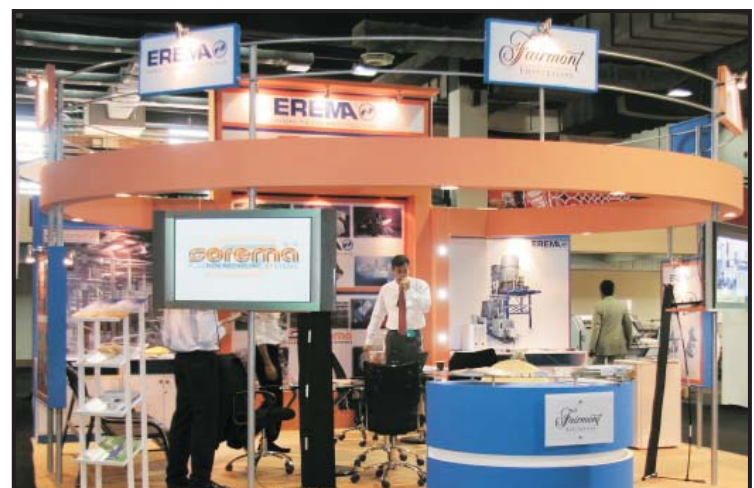

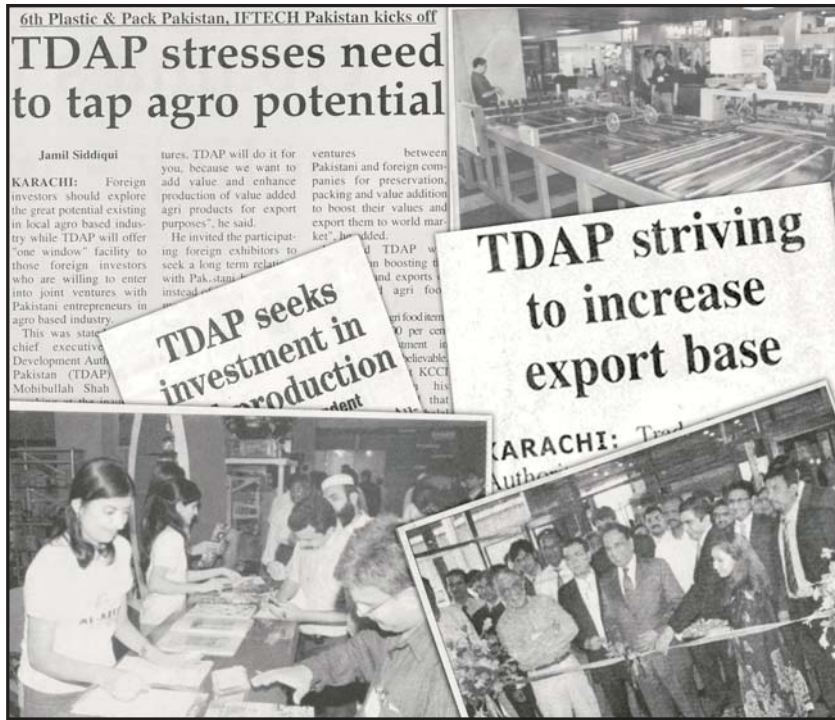
