A. CITY – exhibition

The most interesting architectural projects in St.Petersburg and the Leningrad Region were presented. Projects were demonstrated by Prospekt Architectural Bureau and Architectural Workshop Union 55. The presentation of the Committee for City Planning and Architecture of St.Petersburg included the General Plan of the St.Petersburg Land Use and Development Rules, reconstruction and development projects of large areas (European Embankment, Apraksin Court, New Holland and others), public buildings in the historical context (reconstruction of the Senate and Synod buildings for the Constitutional Court of the Russian Federation), residential buildings in the historical context, reconstruction of historic buildings with new functions (Mariinsky theatre) and other projects.

Visitors were able to see the exposition “City and Home. The architecture of Berlin in the 21st Century”, which was taking place for the first time in St.Petersburg. The exhibition was organised by Proekt Baltiya (Project Baltia) magazine and the organisers of BalticBuild. The exhibition presented the work of leading architects such as David Chipperfield, Hilmer & Sattler und Albrecht and Kleihues + Kleihues and many others, reflecting the transformation of traditional elements of Berlin’s architecture. This travelling exposition has already been shown in other Russian and international cities. The curator was Philip Mozer.

“This is not my first visit to the exhibition. I consider it one of the most prestigious in Russia.

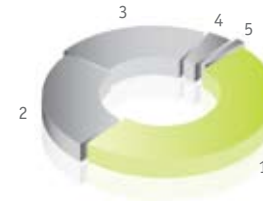

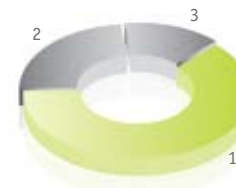

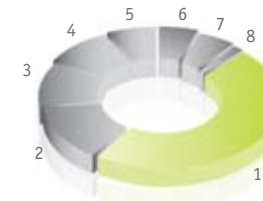

The 22nd World Roofing Championship was held together with the BalticBuild exhibition.

The championship brought together roofers from different countries. Winning the event is very prestigious, as it demonstrates the economic potential of a country and its attitude to vocational qualifications.

24 commands from 13 countries of the world took part in the Championship.

There were three categories in the competition: **“Metal roof”**, participating 6 countries: Belgium, France, Russia, Hungary, Latvia, Poland; **“Tile”**, participating 12 countries: Belgium, Switzerland, Germany, France, England, Hungary, Croatia, the Netherlands, Poland, Russia, Slovenia and Slovakia; **“Waterproof”**, participating 6 countries: Switzerland, Germany, France, England, Poland, Russia.

22nd World Roofing Championship Results:

“Metal roof”:

- 1st place – Hungary
- 2nd place – Latvia
- 3rd place – France

“Waterproof (PVC-membrane and bitum materials)”:

- 1st place – Russia
- 2nd place – Poland
- 3rd place – Germany

“Cement-sandy and natural tile”:

- 1st place – Russia
- 2nd place – Hungary
- 3rd place – Switzerland

The winners were granted with cups, medals and monetary checks.

Except an estimation of the obligatory program, there were awards from Gordon Penrose, President of International Federation of Roofers IFD for the best performance of any task: in nomination **“Metal roof”** (the task – detour of flue and walls covering) – to Hungary. In nomination **“Waterproof”** (“to sew a suit” for a dummy from PVC-membrane) – to Russia. In nomination **“Tile”** (planes covering with material Tegola) – to Germany.

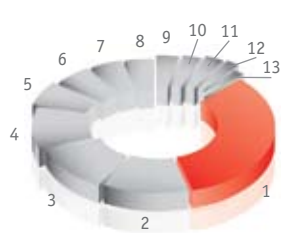
The World Championship jury consisted of 10 persons led by the main judge of competitions. Work of each nomination was estimated by a judiciary board from 3 persons: 2 representatives from the international roofing federation and 1 judge from Russia.

The jury estimated mostly quality, technics, external beauty of the carried out task, ability to organise a workplace, observance of norms of safety, skills of work with the professional tool

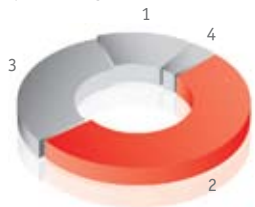

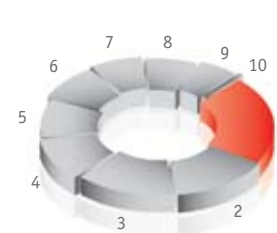

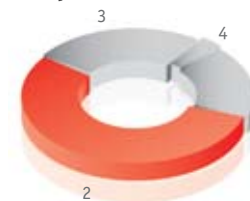

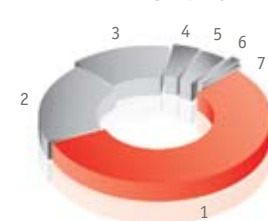

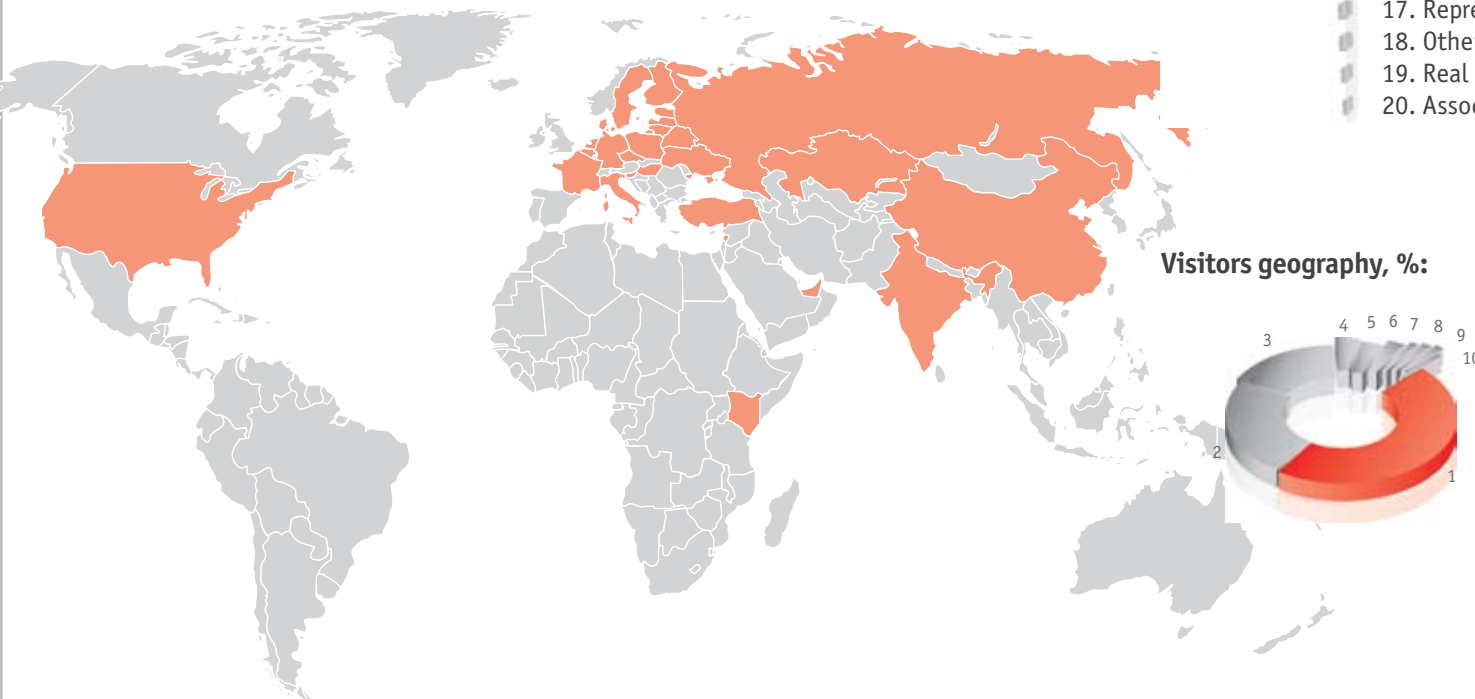

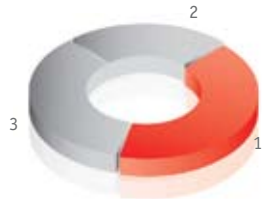


Visitors nature of business, %:



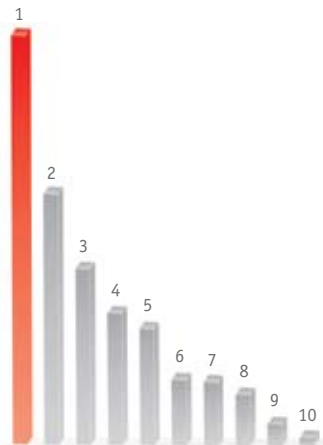

Visitor estimated purchase volume, %:



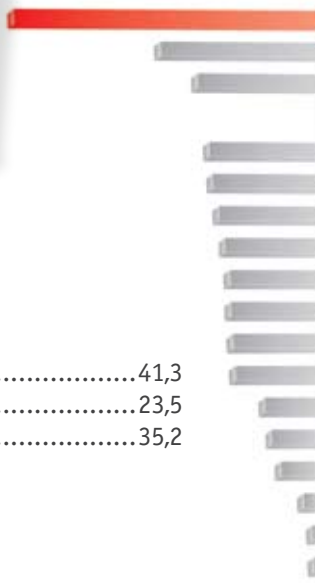

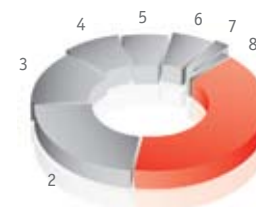
