OS+H Asia 2008, Southeast Asia's premier occupational safety and health exhibition embraced the staunch support from 112 exhibiting companies and brands from 17 countries. The exhibition, held alongside MEDICAL FAIR ASIA 2008 and the 19th Asian Conference on Occupational Health (organized by Singapore's Occupational and Environmental Health Society), played host to 4,263 visitors from 36 countries – the highest ever visitor turnout since its inception in 1998. 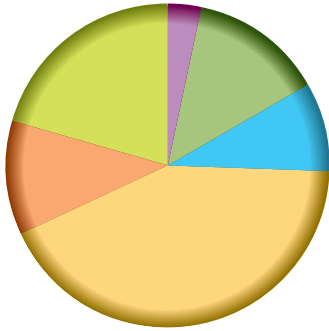

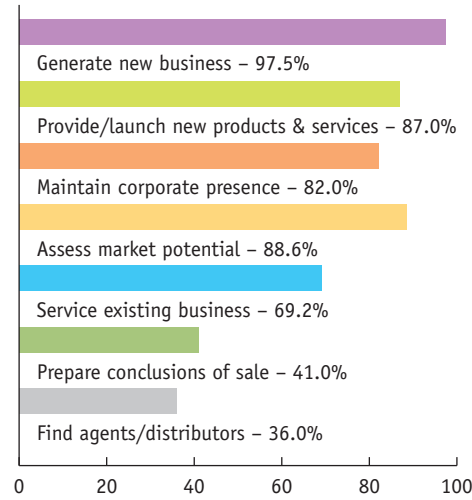

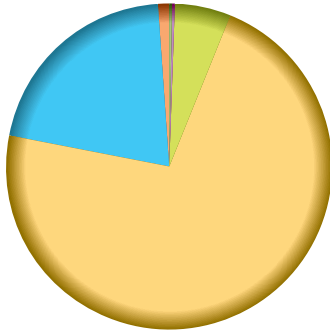

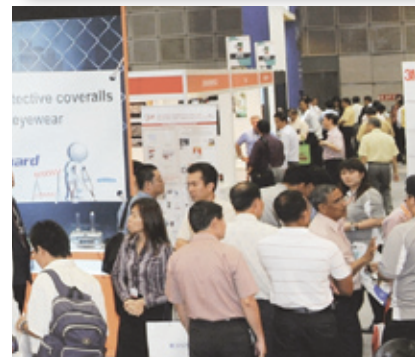
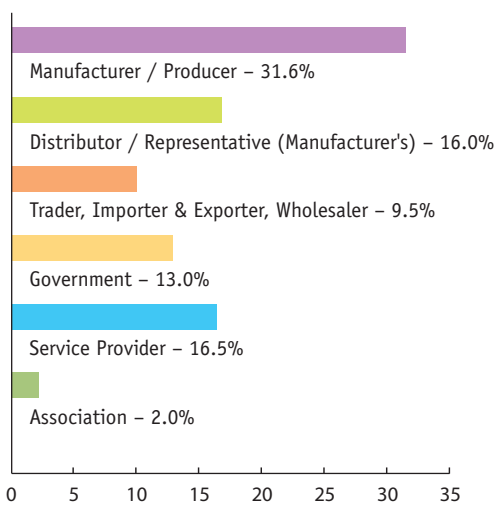
