

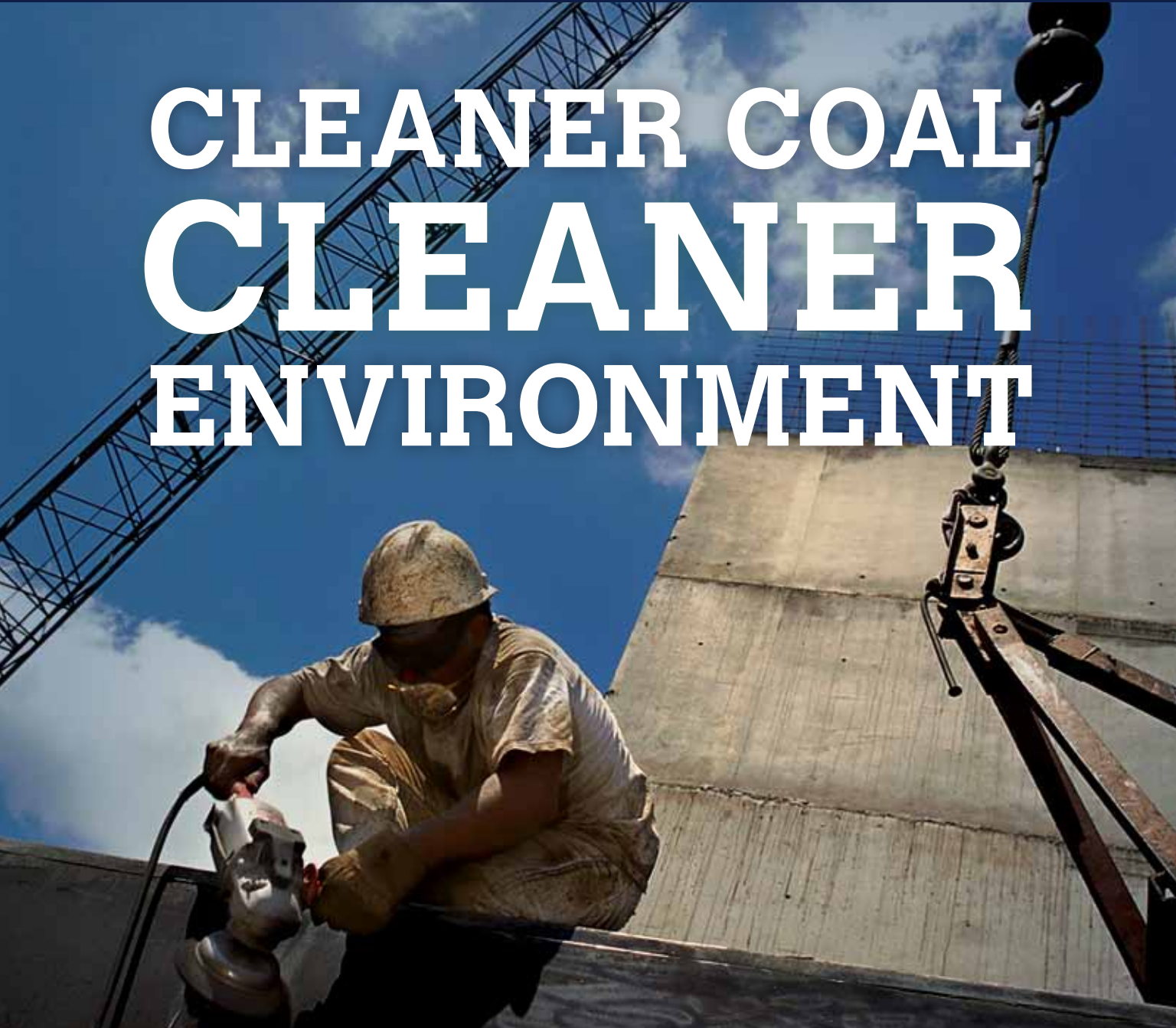

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Introduction

The Coal-Gen 2010 Conference was held August 9 – 12 at the David L. Lawrence Convention Center in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. A Technical Tour of the Bruce Mansfield Station kicked-off the conference, followed by a golf tournament was played at the Quicksilver Golf Club in nearby Midway, Pennsylvania. Four Pre-Conference workshops also took place this day.

On Tuesday, the Keynote Session was honored by three featured speakers, including Mr. James F. Wood, Deputy Assistant Secretary for Clean Coal, Office of Fossil Energy, Department of Energy, Dr. Robert Wayland, Leader Energy Strategies Group, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Prof. Frank Clemente, Professor of Social Science at Penn State University.

The conference content was organized into twenty three individual sessions, as well as two mega-sessions. Six individual tracks included topics such as New Generation, Environmental, Regulatory & CCS Issues, Asset Optimization, Coal Supply, Handling and By-Products, Emerging Clean Coal Technologies and Circulating Fluidized Bed (CFB). The exhibition featured 277 exhibitors presenting products and services within coal energy production. Coal-Gen provided a great opportunity for attendees and exhibitors to network, discuss challenges and solutions within the coal industry.

Event Highlights

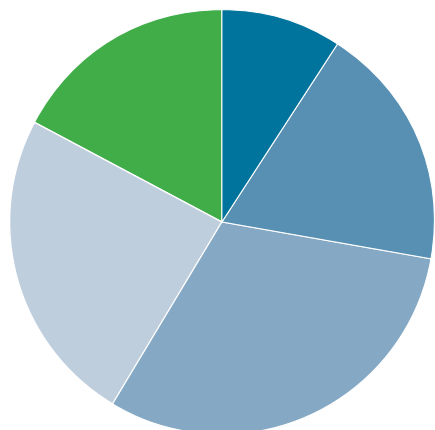

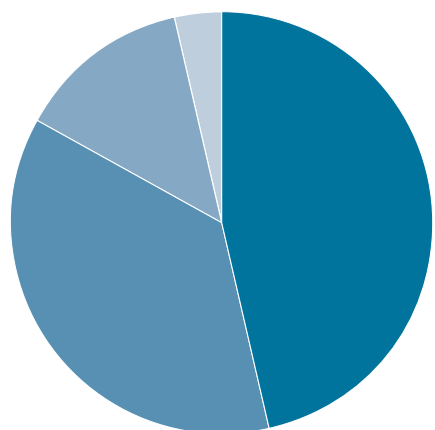

Attendee Profile



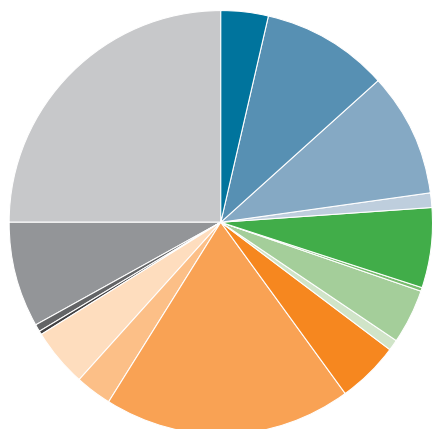
Attendee by Job Function

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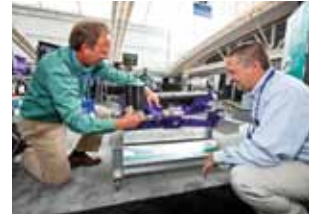
